DR. POLEVSKI RITES HELD

Heart Specialist Was Professor of Cardiac Research and Author.

NEWARK, N. J., July 29.— Funeral services for Dr. Jacob C. Polevski, heart specialist, who died at Johns Hopkins Hospital, Baltimore, on Monday after an operation, were held today at his home here. Rabbis Marius Ranson, Leon S. Lang and Charles Hoffman officiated, Burial was in the King Solomon Cemetery at Clifton. A number of Newark physicians acted as honorary pallbearers.

He was the senior attending physician and cardiologist at Beth Israel Hospital here, and Associate Professor of Cardiac Research at the Graduate Medical School of the University of Pennsylvania. His recent book, "The Heart Visible," was considered an authority on the subject.

Born in Russia forty-nine years ago, Dr. Polevski had practiced medicine here twenty-seven years. He was a graduate of the Bellevue Medical College in New York. He was a member of the Academy of Medicine of Northern New Jersey, the Essex County Medical Society and the National Therapeutic Society. He was active in the Zionist movement.

His widow, three sisters and a brother survive.
